Brief summary of TSDS additions and changes that will require a TxEIS software update.

PreK

PK-Full-Day-Waiver-Indicator-Code – (Data Element E1646) indicates whether the campus has received an exemption from offering a full-day prekindergarten program.

PK-Eligible-Previous-Year-Indicator-Code– (Data Element - E1649) indicates whether a four-year-old student is eligible for enrollment in a prekindergarten class because they were eligible for enrollment at the age of three in the previous school year.

PK-Funding Source-Code – (Code Table -C186) new code 5 early education allotment.

Service Id Updates

(Code Table C022) Revisions, additions, and deletions. Some changes in CTE weighted funding eligibility.

Expanded Learning Opportunities

Student level reporting removed. The ELOs offered at each campus will be reported.

Added new criteria: (Data Element – E0919)

14. Has been incarcerated or has a parent or guardian who has been incarcerated, within the lifetime of the student, in a penal institution as defined by Section 1.07, Penal Code or regardless of the student's age, each student who participates in an adult education program provided under a high school diploma and industry certification charter school program under Section 29.259.

Industry Certifications

New certification codes added - (Code Table -C214)

Nine codes have been revised and many industry certification licensure codes have been added. There are currently 245 industry certification licensure options in the code table.

Dual Credit Course Sequence

New dual credit COURSE-SEQUENCE-CODE (Code Table C135) values are used for dual credit courses only

Sp Ed Effective Date

(Data Element - E1632)

Added new element to be reported in Submission 1 and 3 on the StudentSpecialEdProgramAssociationExtension complex type. (TxEIS Special Ed Application)

Parental Permission Codes

(Code Table - C093) Revised code translations. Deleted codes B and F. Added new code K

Calendar - Instructional Program Type Codes

(Code Table C215) Revised translations for codes 02 and 04. Added new codes 14 and 15.

Dyslexia

Dyslexia Services – (New Data Element E1650)

Dyslexia Risk – (New Data Element E1644) indicates the results of screening for dyslexia and related disorders required under TEC §38.003(a).

This new data element will provide a mechanism for local education agencies to report the outcome of dyslexia and related disorders screening for students in kindergarten and first grade (TxEIS Registration - Demo tab 3)

Census Block

Student census block-group -- (Data Element E1648)

A census block is a geographic unit defined by the U.S. Census Bureau. LEAs can use the tool provided by TEA to determine the Student census block-group

Student census block-group must be reported for students who are economically disadvantaged and eligible for ADA. This includes students (with or without a disability) who reside in a residential facility if they are regularly assigned to the LEA. See TAA letter dated July 12, 2019 and letter dated 9/5/2019. TxEIS will include utilities to export student addresses and import census block data.

Student-Attribution-Code

New attribution codes – new codes 29 and 30 (Data Element E1000, Code Table – C161)

Under HB 2190, TEC section 12.117 is expanded to allow an open-enrollment charter school to admit and receive attendance funding for a child of an employee of the school, regardless of whether the child resides in the geographical attendance area served by the school.

Bilingual/ESL

Bilingual/ESL-Funding -Code (Data Element E1651) indicates the language program in which the student participated during the reporting period.

TEA will use Bilingual/ESL-Funding -Code along with LEP-Indicator-Code to determine the funding weight to be used for calculating the Bilingual Education Allotment.

Alternative-Language-Program-Code (Data Element E1642) indicates the type of alternative language program participated in by the student. An alternative language program must be approved by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) due to the LEAs submission of a bilingual education exception and/or English as a second language (ESL) waiver for the current school year. (See 19 TAC §89.1207.)

Leaver Codes

LEAVER-REASON-CODE (Code Table C162)

New leaver codes - 08 -Pregnancy - Student (female or male) withdrew from/left school because of pregnancy. 20 -Medical Injury -Student has suffered a condition, injury, or illness that requires substantial medical care and leaves the student unable to attend school and assigned to a medical or residential treatment facility. (students withdrawing 2019-2020, reported Fall of 2020)

GT District Reporting

Gifted and Talented –Program-Code (Data Element E1645 and Code Table C223)

Gifted and Talented –Program-Code indicates a gifted and talented program the LEA has established is consistent with the state plan developed under TEC 29.123

CTE

CTE program of study (Data Element E1643 and Code Table C220)

Program of study indicates a program of study the LEA offers.

A program of study is a comprehensive, structured approach for delivering academic and career and technical education to prepare a student for postsecondary education and career success.

CTE funding for 7th and 8th

Reporting of CTE attendance for students in grades 7 and 8. TxEIS attendance reports will be revised.

New Tech Indicator

(Data Element E1647) Added new element to StudentExtension interchange.

New-Tech-Indicator-Code indicates that a student in grades 7-12 is enrolled in a New Tech Network campus as identified by the New Tech Network.

Campus Enrollment Type

Campus Enrollment Type-Code (Data Element E1641 and Code Table C219) specifies the method by which the campus draws student enrollment. (Zoned, open enrollment, selective enrollment, DAEP, etc)

State Performance Plan Indicator 14 (SPPI-14) Collection

Special Education data, Core data collection. SPPI-14 collection will be used to gather data for students with disabilities enrolled in grades 9-12 who have exited a local education agency (LEA) and have a leaver record with certain leaver codes as reported in the 2019-2020 PEIMS Fall submission. Only LEAs that have Special Education students in grades 9-12 and who have a leaver reason code of 01, 24, 88, 90, and 98 will be required to submit SPPI-14 data. See TAA Letter - Dated 5/2/2019.

Class Roster Collection

Teacher classroom link information will be collected through the new Texas Student Data System (TSDS) Class Roster core Collection. See TAA Letter - Dated .6/20/2019.

Residential Facility Submission

Only LEAs that have Residential Facilities in their geographic boundaries will submit this data. See TAA Letter - Dated 4/18/2019.
